POLICY FOR THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED

The framing of the policy entitled "DIVYANGJAN POLICY, SPP COLLEGE, NAMTI" is an integral part of the institutional inclusive goal of making the college premises conducive for the differently able academic aspirants. It essentially requires developing need-based infrastructure and generating relevant awareness as well. In spite of having minimal demand till date, the college at its own initiative has adopted certain measures to introduce and develop certain relevant amenities for upholding a supportive environment of inclusive education for differently able persons. The prime objectives and efforts already made include:

- 1. To assure a barrier-free and accessible to all college building.
- 2. To encourage aspiring students of the Differently Able category to get enrolled in the institution.
- 3. To ensure an environment of equity in which every member is well-aware of never exercising discriminatory behavior.
- 4. To ensure inclusion and effectiveness in the participation of differently able students in different institutional activities.
- 3. To adopt suitable medium and method of teaching (such as individual teaching) for the students of this category.
- 4. To provide assistance to the students in the learning process apart from regular class hours.
- 5. To provide education and training resources/ materials in an accessible format.
- 6. To provide assistance or facility needed in taking up examinations.
- 7. To provide information brochure on the facilities available in the campus.
- 8. To permit such learners to use their own personal assistive devices in the campus.
- 9. To update the facilities available for differently able in the campus.
- 10. To allot certain number of seats for the students of this category.

BROCHURE ON BARRIER FREE ENVIRONMENT

In pursuance of the principle of inclusive education, S.P.P. College envisions a barrier-free environment where people with disabilities can move about safely and freely without any obstacle and inhibition. The environment supports the independent functioning of individuals so that they can participate without assistance in everyday activities within the campus.
